The Job: Our back stamped concrete patio needed to be resealed.

The original sealer was wearing off and some of the stain color was disappearing. We knew we didn't want to deal with the company that originally installed the patio. While the patio had excellent colors and stamping, the sealing was just mopped on. I figured that was "how it's done". That process left bubbles and inconsistent thickness. It was just ugly!

Now was the opportunity to "get it right". After researching the process so I would be smarter about selecting the best contractor, I called several places. Because they scrapped out the old bubbled sealer from the original job, this made the sealer "Better than new!" I was totally blown away with how great it looked. Dave called me that evening to get my opinion of the job and I told him that although it was dusk, it looked great and I would really inspect it in the morning. Dave called me back that afternoon and I told him how fantastic the job was and glad to support a local contractor. After admiring the sealant job for a week, I'm still very pleased.
